Maintenance Work Orders in Equipment Cost

Intersoft adds maintenance work order capabilities to the Equipment Cost System to facilitate tracking of maintenance.

Beaverton, OR, June 1, 2009: A Work Order system has been added into the Equipment Cost module, facilitating the tracking of maintenance records for equipment. Work Orders are composed of a header with basic information such as date, equipment and description of the work to be performed and four types of maintenance records: Purchased Parts, Inventory Parts, Labor and Miscellaneous items.

- Purchased parts can be entered in a W/O Parts file and easily retrieved when entering work order.
- If the INTERAC Inventory module is used, inventory parts can be assigned.
- Work orders can be assigned to specific mechanics (employees) from INTERAC Payroll.
- Miscellaneous items such as freight can also be included.
- If the equipment is being repaired while on a job, a job number can be included as a reference.
- A 300 character description of work can be entered to better describe the tasks
- The system will track both the cost and a resale price with parts and labor if desired.
- With the INTERAC Document Management System (DMS), copies of Work Orders can be automatically attached to the equipment record in the Equipment Master file.
